How about 20?

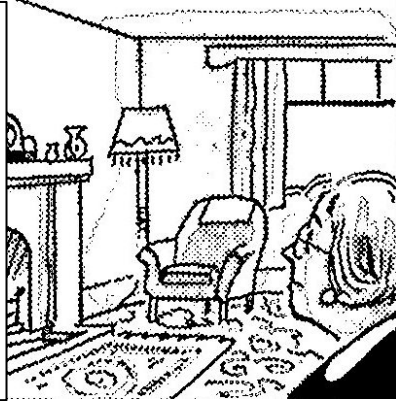
S: I said 13, not 30.

nice	⇒	cute, beautiful, great

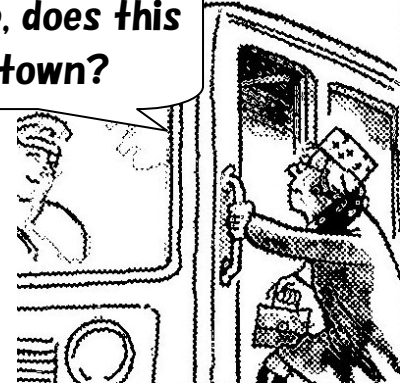
I need a good picture for my living room.

Yes, it does.



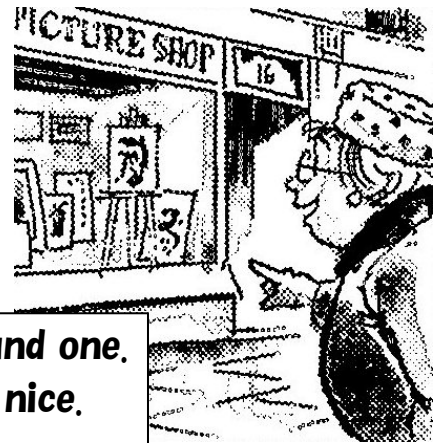
She went to town by bus.

She looked for a picture shop.



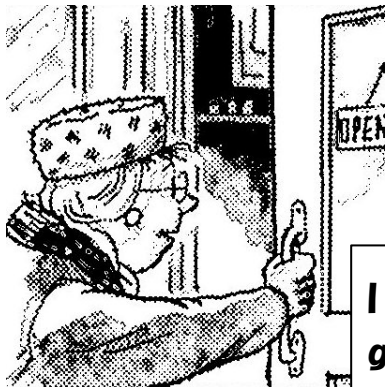
Where is a picture shop?
