J: I think so too. You are not friends!

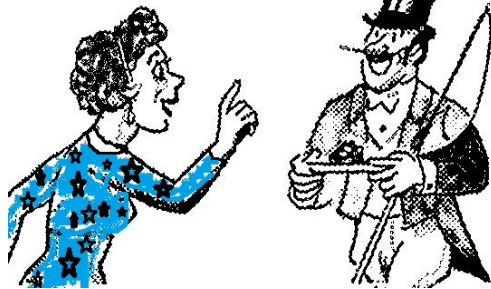
M: The kids are right. Don't be silly.

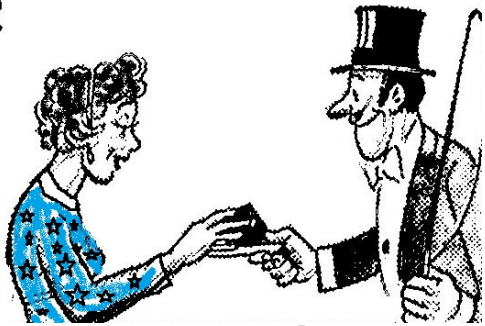

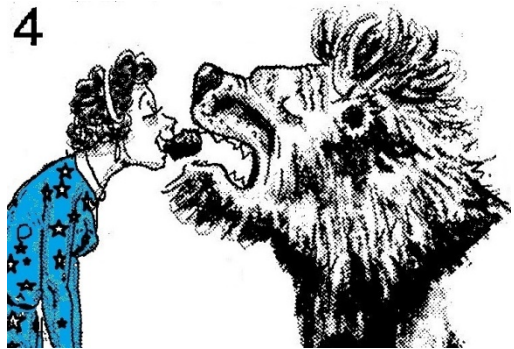

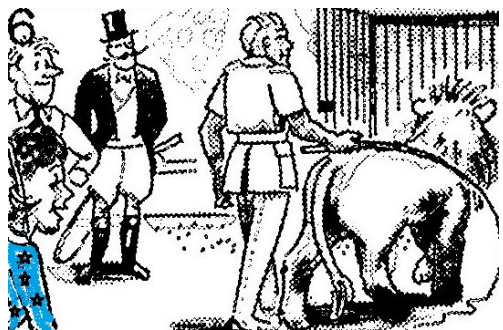
